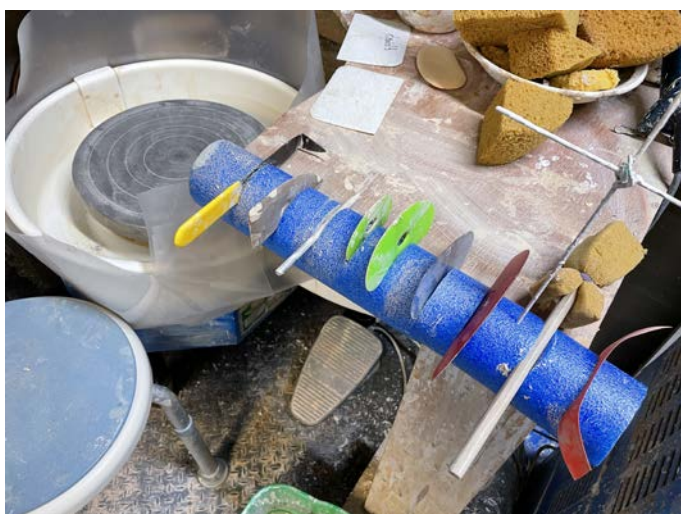
Left: Dereks' sculpture with an unusual crawling glaze.

Our Clayworkers group's work is on display at the Yarraman Gallery.

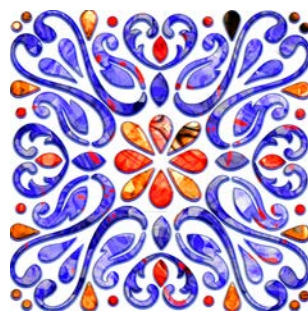
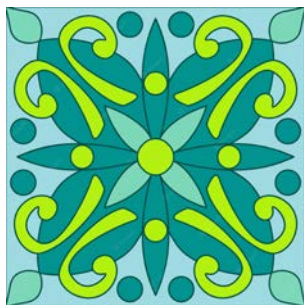
